St. Gregory the Great (September 3) is a Doctor of the Church* and was Pope from 590 to 604 AD. Though most well-known for the creation of Gregorian chant, the sacred plainchant of the Church, Gregory is also remembered for his iconic sermons, many of which are found in the Office of Readings in the Liturgy of the Hours. His tomb is located under an altar at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. He is the patron saint of musicians, singers, students, and teachers.
