St. Gregory the Great (September3) is a Doctor of the Church* and was Pope from 590 to 604 AD. Though most well-known for the creation of Gregorian chant, the sacred plainchant of the Church, Gregory is also remembered for his iconic sermons, many of which are found in the Office of Readings in the Liturgy of the Hours. His tomb is located under an altar at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. He is the patron saint of musicians, singers, students, and teachers. <u>Catholic Apostolate Center</u>

*Doctor of the Church is the title given to certain saints whose writing or preaching is outstanding for guiding the faithful in all periods of the Church's history. Originally the Western Fathers of the Church—Gregory the Great, Ambrose, Augustine, and Jerome—were considered the great doctors of the Church. but the Church has officially added many more names to the original four: Catholic Culture
