Metanoia Manor -A Slow Resurrection



The eleven teenage girls living at Metanoia Manor are escapees of human trafficking, victims of sex slavery. It is not uncommon for slavery to begin at an age when children still believe in Santa Claus.

Mass Graves in Canada—the scandal that wasn't

In 2021, a narrative was released in Canada that Catholic boarding schools—officially called Residential Schools—had buried hundreds of children in unmarked “mass graves” over decades. The narrative exploded overnight, despite there being no hard evidence found. As a result, many Catholic churches were burned down and others vandalized.

As it turned out, what were allegedly skeletons were simply aberrations in the soil, which included things like rocks, tree roots, and other non-human things.



All that was “discovered” were community cemeteries that were once taken care of by towns or Catholic parishes and had since become the property of various Native Reserves. These graves were unmarked because the Native bands had not replaced the wooden crosses that had decayed over many decades. In addition, it was found that churches and municipalities had preserved death and burial records from that period in their archives. [Crisis Magazine](#)
