### St. Andrew Kim Tae-gŏn

#### **Patron Saint of Korea**

"We have received baptism, entrance into the Church, and the honor of being called Christians. Yet what good will this do us if we are Christians in name only and not in fact?"

Born in 1821, Fr Kim was the first native-born Korean priest and one of the country's earliest martyrs. He was only 25 years old when he was tortured and then beheaded for the crime of being a Catholic.

The Vatican will dedicate a new statue of St Andrew Kim Tae-gŏn at St. Peter's Basilica on September 16, the date of his martyrdom. The statue will be installed tin a niche outside the Basilica.

# **Life-affirming support for pregnant mothers**



MiraVia, (Miraculous Way) is a Catholic, nonprofit Corporation in Charlotte, North Carolina.

Since the first pregnant mother's admission in December 1994, the residential program of MiraVia has served 590 mothers and children. The nonresidential outreach programs, established ten years later, have served more than 10,755 mothers and children.

MiraVia also supports a residence for pregnant college students, making it possible for young women who might otherwise have to abandon college plans to complete their college education.
