First Martyr of the Philippines

St. Lorenzo Ruiz was born around 1600 in Manila, Philippines to a Chinese father and a Filipino mother. He was a married man and the father of three children and was professional calligrapher.



His happy life drastically changed when he was falsely accused of murder. For his safety, he joined three Dominican priests who were traveling to Japan as missionaries.

Upon arriving in Japan, they faced persecution and torture at the hands of the Japanese authorities. St. Lorenzo Ruiz was executed by hanging upside down. He was canonized in 1987 by Pope St. John Paul II. His feast day is celebrated on September 28

Nigeria: Father Marcellinus Obioma Okide was kidnapped as he made his way back to his parish on Sept. 17.

Christian Nigerians have experienced insecurity since 2009 when the Boko Haram insurgency began. Since then, this group, along with the Fulani militia, have been carrying out kidnappings and deadly terrorist attacks. Their aim is to turn the country into an Islamic state.

China: Father Joseph Yang was convicted of fraud after he refused to register with the state-sanctioned Chinese Catholic Patriotic Association.

Registration is compulsory and any clergy member found guilty of breaking any of the rules can be cancelled and have his religious functions suspended.

Despite the Vatican-China agreements, signed in 2018 and renewed in 2022, government control and persecution of Christians and other religious groups in China has continued to escalate.
