Mary, the Immaculate Conception Patron Saint of the United States and Brazil **December 8**

The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary is about God's extraordinary intervention in the life of the Blessed Virgin Mary, so that from very the moment of her own conception, she was free from the power of original sin. It is not to be confused with another mysterious and miraculous event, the Virgin Birth of the Lord Jesus.

There's more than one St Nicholas

The "St Nick" we hear about at Christmas time is not the only St Nicholas.

St. Nicholas Owen, a Jesuit lay brother and one of the Forty Martyrs of England and Wales: Until his arrest in 1606, Nicholas Owen travelled the country building priest holes in Catholic homes. Over a period of eighteen years, he saved an untold number of priests from the gallows, enabling them to continue ministering to England's beleaguered Catholics in their hour of darkest need.

Blessed Nicholas Postgate, a priest and one of the Eighty-Five Martyrs of England and Wales beatified by St. John Paul II in 1987: He clandestinely served Catholics in the remote Yorkshire moors for almost fifty years before finally being betrayed by a spy and arrested. He was over eighty years old when he was executed in 1679. Crisis Magazine
