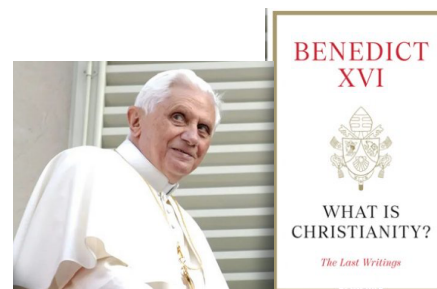


*Set a guard over our priests, O Lord.

Words of wisdom from Pope Benedict’s last book

1. St. Joseph’s silent wisdom.

No words of St Joseph are recorded in scripture, but his life was a constant “yes” to God, his actions speaking louder than words. As Pope Benedict XVI put it: “His silence is at the same time his message.”
