

## <u>The Virgin of San Juan</u> de Los Lagos

A pilgrimage to San Juan de Los Lagos begins on Candelaria (February 2). It is a nine-day walk from San Miguel to San Juan de Los Lagos, in Jalisco.

The image of the Virgin of San Juan de los Lagos was created by an artist in Pátzcuaro, Michoacán probably in the mid-15th century.. It was taken to San Juan de Los Lagos, but remained forgotten for eighty years.

In about 1623, a little girl who had died from a stabbing returned to life because of the intercession of the Virgin.

After that miracle, the image was moved to the cathedral of San Juan de Los Lagos where it remains today. <u>ACI Prensa</u>

### Christian Genocide in Nigeria?

Nigerian Bishop Anagbe has warned that if the government does not take stronger action, he believes the Christian population, which currently numbers over 86 million, roughly half of the total Nigerian population, could disappear entirely in the next few decades.

Despite the great numbers of Christians in Nigeria, the bishop said that the Christian presence there is "gradually and systematically" being reduced by radical Islamists through killings, kidnappings, torture, and burning of churches. In the last decade, the bishop said that his diocese lost 160 churches to attacks by radical members of a the Muslim Fulani tribe. <u>Catholic News Agency</u>

### Origin of the Prayer to St Michael

Pope Leo XIII composed the prayer to St Michael after having a mystical experience of a conversation between Jesus and Satan. He believed that Satan bragged that he could destroy the Church in 75 to 100 years and that Jesus gave him permission to try. He suggested that the prayer be recited after every Mass. Though use throughout the Church was discontinued in 1964, in 1994, Pope John Paul II recommended its use in the battle against the forces of darkness in our world. <u>Simply Catholic</u>
