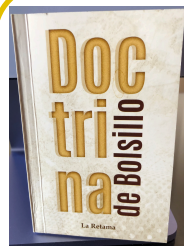

- The fifth, to give alms to the pilgrim;
- The sixth, to free prisoners;
- The seventh, to bury the dead.

The seven spiritual works of Mercy are:

- The first, to instruct the ignorant;
- The second, to give good counsel those who need it;
- The third, to correct the sinner;
- The fourth, to pardon injuries;
- The fifth, to console the sorrowful;
- The sixth, to suffer patiently the failings of others;
- The seventh, to pray for the living and the dead.

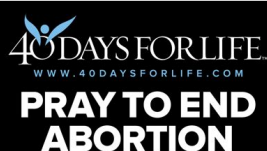
