### A Holy Life



Sister Nijolė Sadūnaitė was a clandestine religious in Soviet-occupied Lithuania. In 1975, she was arrested for her part in producing an underground publication that exposed Lithuanian life under the Soviets. She was

sentenced to the Gulag where she was tortured, confined to a mental institution, and then exiled.

In 1982, she went underground for five years to escape the KGB. During that time, she wrote *A Radiance in the Gulag* (Bookfinder), a memoir of her prison camp experiences. All this time, she kept her religious consecration secret from all but a few friends and family.

She died this year, on Easter Sunday. Her funeral Mass was celebrated with most of Lithuania's bishops present. <u>Catholic World Report</u>



### The US bishops and the abortion pill

Among their many concerns about the safety of chemical abortion, the bishops warned about the lack of safeguards through deregulation: in-person doctor visits are not required, the drug can be delivered through the mail, and access to minors is permitted. In addition, ultrasounds to determine the gestational age of the baby and to detect a dangerous ectopic pregnancy are not required.

### **Abortion pills from San Miguel**

There is an NGO organization here in San Miguel, the San Miguel Reproductive Freedom Fund, that sells abortion pills to women in the US at a very low cost. They are sent into the US illegally either by mail or by hand-carrying them.
