### First martyr of Oceania

In 1836, French Marist priest Peter Chanel was sent to Western Oceania, to the island of Futuna in the New Hebrides.



Peter lived in severe poverty and though he mastered the language of the whalers, traders, and warring natives who lived on the island, his ministry met resistance and persecution from the natives—only a few natives had been baptized and a few more were being instructed. When the chieftain's son asked to be baptized, persecution escalated. Father Chanel was clubbed to death and his body dismembered.

However, just two years after his death, his efforts bore fruit: the whole island became Catholic and remains Catholic to this day.

He was canonized by Pope Pius XII in 1954. Peter Chanel is the first martyr of Oceania and its patron. His feast day is April 28. [EWTN](#); [Franciscan Media](#)
