Flannery O'Connor was a rarity: a southerner and a devout Catholic. She died of Lupus in 1964 at the age of 39, but despite her short life, she is considered by many to be among the best writers of the 20th century. A new movie about her life and works, "Wildcat," opened May 3 in the US. Trailer;

Her stories and novels are not light reading but they are thoughtprovoking and enrich our understanding of human nature and the working of God's grace in our lives.



Kansas priest to be honored with a statue at the Kansas State Capitol



Servant of God Father Emil Joseph Kapaun, a Kansas native, a military chaplain, and a candidate for sainthood, died May 23, 1951, in a North Korean prisoner of war camp. He rejected numerous opportunities to escape and instead volunteered to minister to his fellow prisoners. He was awarded the Medal of Honor in 2013.
