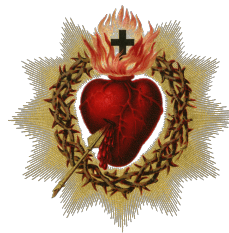
### CORPUS CHRISTI

### A record atrocity

Nearly 200 Christians slaughtered in Nigeria

Benue State, a region of Nigeria which is more than 95 percent Catholic, is the target of carefully coordinated attacks by Fulani Muslims. Hundreds have fled their homes to what they hoped would be a safe haven, but the militants found their shelter and, shouting "Allahu Akhbar," shot, macheted, or burned 200 men, women, and children.
