Donating a vital organ is intended to be a generous gift of life, but a four-year investigation of organ transplant practices revealed “systemic ethical and safety violations.” Most violations involved allowing the organ procurement process to proceed when patients still showed signs of life.

Health and Human Services Secretary Robert F Kennedy called this “horrifying,” and called for accountability and the overhaul of the entire system so that the life of the donor is treated with dignity.

Twelve new priests for Arlington, VA Diocese

In a 2008 address, Pope Benedict told the U.S. bishops that “the ability to cultivate vocations to the priesthood and the religious life is a sure sign of the health of a local Church.”

The group of twelve newly ordained priests in Arlington, VA, is an exception to the current trend. A ten-year study found that, in general, more priestly vocations

come from rural areas where families and communities are closer knit. And especially interesting is that more vocations come from the predominately protestant South than in States that have a larger percentage of Catholics.

Let us pray that those whom God has chosen will hear and heed His voice.
