

Saint Teresa Benedicta of the Cross

(October 12, 1891—August 9, 1942) 9 August—Memorial of her death at Auschwitz

"We bow down before the testimony of the life and death of Edith Stein, an outstanding daughter of Israel and at the same time a daughter of the Carmelite Order, Sister Teresa Benedicta of the Cross, a personality who united within her rich life a dramatic synthesis of our century. It was the synthesis of a history full of deep wounds that are still hurting...and also the synthesis of the full truth about man. Church needs to change with the times. That is not an accurate understanding of Newman's point.

Perhaps it was to clarify this that Pope Leo chose *now* to honor him with the very special title of 'Doctor of the Universal Church.' [It] "suggests that Leo is quite well aware of this 'modernist' temptation, and wishes to

draw those in danger of being seduced by the idea of the possible 'evolution' of doctrine back to the orthodox position proclaimed by Newman: that doctrine may *develop*, but *not change*, not "evolve."

Moynihan Letter #55:

CS Lewis explained it this way: "When we say that a puppy develops into a dog, we do not mean that his growth is a gradual compromise with a cat; we mean that he becomes more doggy and not less. Development is the expansion of all the possibilities and implications of a doctrine..."
