The solemnity of the Assumption is a Holy Day of Obligation in the US; in Mexico, it is not. Nevertheless, you may want to honor Our Lady by attending Mass on the 15th. (8AM or 6PM)

The Assumption was already a common belief in the Church when, on November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII defined the Assumption of Mary to be a dogma of faith: "...that the immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthy life, was assumed body and soul to heavenly glory." The four Marian Dogmas

- 1. Mary is the Mother of God.
- 2. Mary is a perpetual virgin.
- 3. Mary was conceived without original sin: Immaculate Conception.
- 4. Mary was assumed, body and soul, into Heaven: the Assumption.
