### **Dogs of the Lord**

When St. Dominic Guzman's mother was pregnant with him, she dreamt of a dog with a torch in its mouth, running around the world and setting everything on fire. A monk told her that the child in her womb would be a great preacher who would set the world on fire with his words. And, in fact, that's what happened. St Dominic Guzman is said to have converted 100,000 people through his preaching and, in addition, he founded the Order of Preachers—the Dominicans—in 1216. "Dominican" is a play on the Latin phrase *Domini canes*—dogs of the Lord." CNA
