#### **Blessed Isadore**



One of "the least brothers" of Jesus, Isadpre Bakanjawas born in northeast Zaire (then, Belgian Congo) sometime between 1885 and 1890. He freely shared his faith in his native village, but moved to another one to find work. There those in control hated Christians. When he was ordered to remove his scapular, he refused and for his disobedience was flogged until the bones in his back were visible. He was rescued, but too late to save him an agonizing death. He was beatified by Pope John Paul II in 1994.
