The feast of the <u>Exaltation of the Holy Cross</u> celebrates two historical events: the discovery of the True Cross under the



temple of Venus in Jerusalem in 320 by Saint Helena, the mother of the Emperor Constantine, and the dedication in 335 of the basilica and shrine built by Constantine on Calvary to mark the site of the Crucifixion
