"The Diocese of Tlaxcala, the oldest in Mexico, is commemorating the quincentennial of its canonical establishment with a 500-hour period of continuous Eucharistic adoration before the Blessed Sacrament as an expression of

gratitude and renewal of faith."

A jubilee Mass will be celebrated on October 12. The celebrant will be Archbishop Joseph Spiteri, apostolic nuncio to Mexico.

The first Mass to be celebrated in New Spain (now Mexico) was held in 1519. In 1527, the Dominican friar Julián Garcés arrived

> in Tlaxcala and formally established the episcopal see in the Church of the Assumption. CNA

Mexico is a dangerous place for priests

Another priest has been found murdered, this time in the southern cartel-infested state of Guererro.

Robert Royal, author of *The Martyrs* of the New Millennium states that more than 80 priests have been

murdered in Mexico in the last 19 years. Church authorities see "aggressive and systematic" intimidation toward priests. Last year alone, 900 cases of extortion and death threats against priests were recorded and an average of 26 churches were vandalized every week. Zenit, CNA
