



A year after Franciscan Father Antonio Margil and a group of missionaries founded a mission in Nacogdoches, a small town in East Texas, a drought hit the region, forcing many to leave,

Father Margil, after spending a night in prayer for his people, received a vision that showed him a spot near a creek. The next morning, he led a group to the place and, like Moses, struck his staff against a rock. Immediately water flowed from two spots, giving the place its name of "The Eyes of Margil." Today the spring is still there and is a pilgrimage destination.
