Halloween or All Souls'?

We should not conflate Halloween and All Souls' Day nor allow our children and grandchildren to do so.

Our Bishop reminds Catholics to maintain the purity of the faith, that it not be contaminated with other "neopagan" elements that seem to be overshadowing



the Christian sense of the day. "For us the importance of the celebration of the day and above all the Eucharist for all the faithful departed must be kept very clear: we go to the cemetery to pray for the souls of our departed loved ones. We are not worshipping the cult of death, nor of the calaveras, nor witches; we believe in the present life and in eternal life." Diocese of Celaya
