## Jimmy Lai Sentenced

Hong Kong publisher Jimmy Lai, 78, dared to criticize the Chinese Communist Party (CCP) in his publication, *Apple Daily*. For that, he was accused of sedition and jailed in 2021. This week, after spending at least 1800 days in solitary confinement, he was finally sentenced to twenty years in prison for the crime of being a "threat" to national security.



Back in 1997 when the British government handed over Hong Kong to China, the CCP promised to preserve Hong Kong's freedoms for at least fifty years, but that promise was broken. In 2020, the CCP instituted a National Security Law aimed at silencing dissent and prohibiting free expression and peaceful assembly. Jimmy Lai was caught in that trap.

Jimmy, a devout Catholic since 1997, has not wallowed in self-pity. Instead, he has used the time in solitary confinement as a spiritual retreat. The family Christmas card included his sketch of the Annunciation and this witness to his faith: "I am always in God's presence because of prayers [from people I don't know all around the world]. I am so thankful the Lord gave me a new life, a life of true peace, joy, spiritual concreteness and meaning..."



"The verdict in Jimmy Lai's trial has sparked outrage from governments around the world. It remains to be seen whether the CCP will be moved to justice.
