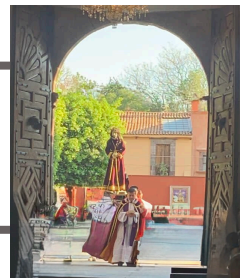

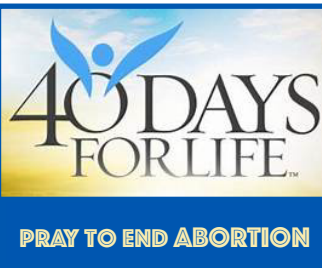

## The Passing Bell - The Bell of San Remo

Ring the Passing Bell when a parishioner died was once a tradition in many Catholic churches.

Bishop Antonio Suetta, of Ventimiglia-San Remo in Italy, revived that tradition on last December 28, the feast of the Holy Innocents. The bell of San Remo rings for one minute every night at 8pm to commemorate the babies who lost their lives to abortion that day.



In the United States, is estimated that there are about 2,800 abortions per day. That averages out to roughly one murder every three minutes. "What if, every night in America, at least one church bell tolled for one minute, disturbing our intellectual slumbers for 60 seconds to remind us of the almost 3,000 fellow Americans who died that day?"
