Safe Haven Baby Boxes offers a safe alternative: A mother can leave her baby in a safe incubator-like box at a fire station or police station with no questions asked. This heart-breaking sacrifice is an act of great love; the mother's comfort is knowing that her baby will be adopted by a caring family.



There are at least 425 Safe Haven Baby Boxes in the US. The organization also offers counseling and information about options for safe surrenders through their national hotline.
