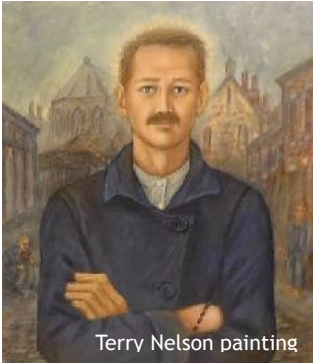

Patron of Alcoholics and Addicts

After a struggle with alcoholism in his youth, Matt stayed sober for forty-one years, until the end of his life. His quiet life of deep faith has become an inspiration for all who struggle with addiction, and a model for all who desire, in the words of Pope Pius XII, "the greatness of Christianity lived in all its fullness."

Leo XIV: Don't Water Down Christianity

The Pope emphasized that today's cultural climate weakens our ability to pursue truth because "[e]very message risks being perceived as just one opinion among many." Nevertheless, "[it] is certainly not by watering down the content or softening the demands that Christianity can be made attractive but by bearing witness with humility and courage to 'the way, the truth, and the life' that has converted and sanctified so many people." Magnifica Humanitas, Pope Leo's first encyclical, warns us and challenges us about the societal implications of AI.

In the encyclical, the Pope quotes some of Gandalf's words of wisdom to the hobbit Frodo in J.R.R. Tolkien's *Lord of the Rings* as they discuss the growing shadow of evil in Middle-Earth.
