Freemasonry is incompatible with Catholicism

In response to widespread confusion in the Nordic countries, the June 29th pastoral letter from the Nordic Bishops' Conference reiterated the universal law of the Church that prohibits Catholics, without exception, from joining Masonic associations:

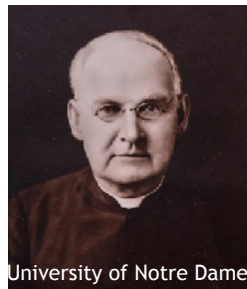


"...the faithful who enroll in Masonic associations are in a state of grave sin and may not receive Holy Communion."

In several encyclicals, Leo XIII condemned Freemasonry for its religious indifferentism and its quasi religious nature. For instance, its initiation ritual professes to bring the new member from darkness into the light. [The Pillar](#)

When in 1939 **Rhoda Wise (1888-1948)** reported a miraculous healing of her stomach cancer and an incurable wound, hundreds of people began to visit her and hundreds reported miraculous healings both before and after her death. After Mother Angelica (Rita Rizzo) was healed of a stomach ailment, Rhoda became her friend and spiritual mentor. [EWTN News](#)

Sigrid Undset (1882-1949) won the Nobel Prize for literature in 1928 for her trilogy *Kristen Lavransdatter*, a powerful story set in medieval Norway that examines the themes of sin and grace, suffering and repentance.



The bishop sponsoring her cause sees her as a witness to the saving grace of God in her life, a defender of the Catholic faith, and a strong opponent of Nazism during World War II.
